
I am directed to refer to the letter Memo No. Reggr./A-1/2017/3484 dated 08.08.2017 received from the Registrar, LLUVAS on the subject mentioned above and to say that the proposal of admission of International Institute of Veterinary Education and Research, Rohtak submitted to the Central Government as per Veterinary Council of India (Procedure of recognition and de-recognition of veterinary colleges and veterinary qualification) Rules, 2017 has been considered in the Advisory Committee constituted under Rule 16 of the said Rules. The Advisory Committee deputed inspection team on 1st to 3rd September, 2017 to inspect the Institution for grant of Letter of Permission under Rule 8(1) of Veterinary Council of India (Procedure of recognition and de-recognition of veterinary colleges and veterinary qualification) Rules, 2017 with respect to B.V.Sc & A.H. degree course as per MSVE Regulation, 2016.

2. The Advisory Committee submitted report to the Central Government and the same has been considered in the Central Government by the Competent Authority. Accordingly, the International Institute of Veterinary Education and Research, Rohtak is granted Letter of Permission as per Rule 8(1) of Veterinary Council of India (Procedure of recognition and de-recognition of veterinary colleges and veterinary qualification) Rules, 2017 to admit students upto 80 (eighty) for First year and continuing education for Second to Third year B.V.Sc & A.H course during 2017-18 as per MSVE Regulation, 2016.

3. However, no admission shall be made in the Fourth year of the B.V.Sc & A.H. course until (i) the Institute complies with the requirement of faculty and infrastructure as per MSVE Regulations, 2016 three weeks prior to start of 4th year academic session and (ii) specific approval to conduct the Fourth year B.V.Sc & A.H courses by the Competent Authority of Central Government. The details of manpower and deficiencies is enclosed at **Annexure-I**.

4. Further, it also mentioned that if any time stated faculty and facilities are found lacking, it may deem withdrawal of said Letter of Permission etc. and it will be treated as fraudulent intent to mislead the Government and students by statement of wrongful

compliance which shall be an offence under Law and the Competent Authority shall be free to take any action, as deem fit, in accordance with provisions of the Law including annulment of Letter of Permission and any concurrence for further veterinary education by the Institution.
